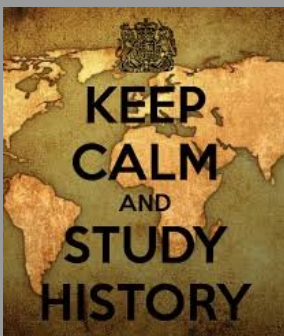

## Course Structure

The Humanities - History course gives learners access to personalised learning, allowing them to combine units that are suitable for their individual needs. Pupils will study -

### **'A British Society in the Past'**

This unit helps learners to understand the key features that affected British lives in the past. This will be taught through a study of short periods of British history. In particular learners will be taught about similarities and differences between past and present and the use of historical sources.

### **'A Non-British Society in the Past'**

This unit will help learners to understand the key features that affected people's lives in the past. This will be through a study of a short period of non-British history focusing on a specific society. In particular,

learners will be taught about similarities and difference between past and present and the use of historical sources.

### **'Looking at your History'**

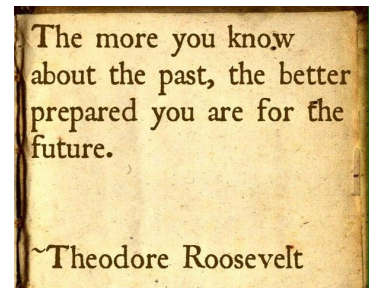
In this unit, learners will study historical issues of local interest and importance.

### **'People and Protest'**

This unit will enable learners to gain knowledge of the reasons why people sometimes resort to protest, the different methods used to protest and whether protest is ever successful.

### **'Persecution of People'**
