Course Structure

"This is a personal development course providing a unique, practical approach to learning which supports young people to fulfil their potential."

The programme provides an opportunity to try out new activities, boost your confidence and gain a recognised Prince's Trust qualification.

As part of the course you will explore the following Personal and Social Development; Life Skills; Active Citizenship; Enterprise Project and Preparation for Work.

There are nine modules including teamwork; participating in exercise; managing money; preparing for a healthy lifestyle; digital skills; community project; enterprise project; presentation skills and career planning.

Pupils are set a number of challenges and gain credit when they have successfully completed the portfolios of evidence.

Throughout this course there are opportunities to gain extra credits (e.g. Food Hygiene, First Aid, Fire Safety Awareness,)

Good attendance is essential, due to the nature of the course.
