Dear Parent /Guardian,

We are close to the end of the year and we are all making plans for the next.

We would like to take this opportunity to remind you that we have a strict uniform code, both for the next half term and in September.

At Cefn Saeson, we believe that school uniform is an important part of the ethos adopted by the school. We work hard at creating a happy, friendly atmosphere, which is often commented on by visitors to the school, and we believe that our children's appearance contributes to these very positive comments. We ask all parents to continue to support us in upholding these high standards.

School trousers must be black, tailored, office type trouser. Skinny jeans, trousers containing rivets/studs, or those made from a material containing Lycra will not be accepted. Plain black leather flat shoes must accompany these trousers or black leather trainers with no markings on them, these trainers must be leather as the canvas shoes will leak in the rain. From September, school jumpers will be mandatory; this means that all pupils will need to wear the jumper at all times. Should pupils not have a jumper they will be given a spare one to borrow for the day. This not only prevents pupils wearing hoodies but ensures that they are warm during the winter.

We are currently reviewing the policy on allowing earrings. The rule is that one pair of studs is allowed in the lobe of the ear; no piercing of any other kind is acceptable. However, now we are seeing piercings in noses and ear bars being worn. Please understand if this continues a return to the No jewellery rule will be considered.

No other jewellery is not allowed (with the exception of a wristwatch, please remember that smart watches are not allowed as they break examination practice rules.)

It is for this reason that we advise that all new piercings be done at the beginning of the summer holidays so they will be fully healed on their return to school and can therefore be removed before entering school.

Pupils who refuse to remove jewellery or not conforming to the uniform policy will be sent home to change.

False nails of any kind are not allowed in school, nail varnish must be clear or a short French nail polish is allowed. Injuries have occurred as a result of wearing false nails and therefore they are
