The Options Process



Please make sure you have read the information regarding Option Choices on the school website. Before completing your choices please read these instructions carefully.

Gain as much detail and information on the subject before you make your choice. You need to speak to your subject teacher, look at past reports, and speak to pupils currently doing the subject.

- Select a subject for the correct reasons, i.e. past performance, careers advice, enjoyment of the subject.
- If you any questions relating to Careers guidance please speak to our Careers officer Mrs A O'Leary.
- Do not select a subject for the following reasons liking the teacher, taking a subject because a friend is taking it, taking it because it 'sounds' nice, without understanding the work required.
- Select 4 subjects and 2 reserve subjects.
- Once we have all requests in, we will produce a list of subjects in 4 options columns that meet the requirements of the majority of pupils. Once this is completed, pupils will then select a subject from each column. This should match the initial selection.
- The Options form needs to be returned to the main office by Monday 27th January 2020
 We try very hard to fulfil your option choices. However, there may be times where we will be unable to meet these requests. If there are low numbers for a specific subject or the courses are oversubscribed then we will negotiate further options with you.
