Learners develop:

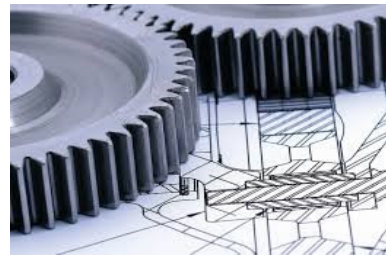
- skills required for independent learning and development;
