1. Absolutism- the view that certain actions are good or bad.
2. Ethics- the philosophical study of right and wrong.
3. Morality- ideas or principles about what is right or wrong.
4. Relativism- the view that whether an action is good or bad depends on the situation.
5. Utilitarianism- the theory that the best action in any situation is the one which creates the greatest amount of good for the greatest number.
6. Hedonic calculus- Jeremy Bentham's way of calculating which actions are right

and wrong.

7. Thought experiment- an imaginary scenario invented to examine the consequences of a philosophical idea.

8. Free will – the belief that we are completely free

9. Hard determinism – the belief that all our actions are determined by prior causes therefore we have no freewill.

10. Soft determinism - the belief that we are partly free but also partly not free.
