Updates on School Uniform

Dear Parents and Carers,

We have valued parent and pupil voice throughout this year in respect of the school uniform. Our endeavour has been to work towards ensuring full inclusivity, comfort and sensible financial management.

As you know, we have enabled plain white polo shirts throughout the summer which has helped pupils in the warmer temperatures, whilst managing the costs. We know that this has been well received by pupils and families, and we appreciate the adherence by all, as pupils have maintained good presentation which does support their learning mindsets.

Above this, we have agreed to phase out the blazers at Key Stage 4 (Year 10 and Year 11) from September and to move to those year groups to also having shirts and jumpers (with the school logo), like Key Stage 3. Pupils and parents fed back that the material of the blazers does not lend to comfort but also changing uniform between Key Stage 3 and Key Stage 4 has added on costs for families.

If pupils currently have blazers for Year 10 and Year 11 for next year, they will still be permitted to wear them and we will support a phased approach away from the blazers. The blazers can be worn until they are too small or not fit for purpose.

When purchasing new items, prioritising the jumper over the blazer will help the gradual transition process. Thank you, once again, for your detailed contributions.
